

Item No. 2. Disposal of cases in the State Information Commission, Haryana.

Item No. 3 Retention of Staff after 65 years.

The Commission's Secretariat relieved Shri Kuldeep Singh Bains, Personal Assistant attached with Shri Narender Yadav, State Information Commissioner on attaining the age of 65 years. Shri Narender Yadav, SIC stated that Shri Kuldeep Singh Bains is not only sincere but also hardworking and trusted personnel. Shri Narender Singh Yadav, SIC recommended that he may be allowed to continue with him. The matter was placed before the Commission. It was stated by many Commissioners that the Commission is having acute shortage


of experienced and efficient Personal Assistants. If we relieve efficient, hardworking and willing officials on attaining the age of 65 years, then the work of Commission will suffer badly. Different Commissions of Haryana are retaining retired employees till the age of 70 years. Even State Government has been re-employing efficient staff even beyond the age of 70 years.

Thus, it was decided that experienced PAs/Stenographers may be allowed to work in the Commission even after attaining the age of 65 years on the specific recommendations of concerned State Information Commissioner on case to case and year to year basis. In the meantime, the Commission's Secretariat will take steps to get the services engaged of the experienced PAs/Stenographer below the age of 65 years. The interest of efficiency of the working of the Commission shall be of paramount importance. Office be directed to take necessary action in view of above decision.
