The following decisions were taken in the meeting:-

**Item No.1: Action taken on the minutes of the meeting of the Commission held on 16.04.2018.**

**Item No.2: Disposal of cases in the State Information Commission, Haryana.**

However, all were requested to expedite the disposal of cases especially old cases.

**Item No. 3: Matter regarding 'on-line' portal for filing of RTI application in the State of Haryana on the pattern of Central Govt.**

The status of 'on-line' portal for filing of RTI application was discussed. It was informed that:-

- NIC completed the development of RTI portal for receiving and disposal of RTI applications having interface for citizen with Payment Gateway, departmental Administrator, PIOs, APIOs.
- Application has been put up for Security Audit with Information Security Management Office (ISMO) after User Acceptance Testing (UAT) from the SIC, Haryana.
- First Phase of testing has been cleared by Information Security Management Office. Now it has been further

put up for security audit at Centre of Development of Advance Computing (C-DAC), Hyderabad as it involve Payment Gateway.

- First Security audit report has been received from Centre of Development of Advance Computing and problems have been rectified and informed to C-DAC on 28-03-2018. Response from Centre of Development of Advance Computing is awaited.


Office is directed to take up the matter with Chief Secretary to Govt., Haryana (in Administrative Reforms Branch) and all other concerned to expedite the matter.

**Item No.4: Other points discussed.**

- i) All the State Information Commissioners were requested to submit their T.A./D.A. and Medical Claim bills etc. expeditiously so that the payment of same can be made during the quarter, in view of provision of quarterly capping by the Finance Department.
- ii) **Section 19(8)(a)(vi)** which is reproduced as under:-  
**19 (8)** In its decision, the Central Information Commission of State Information Commission, as the case may be, has the power to –  
**a)** require the public authority to take any such steps as may be necessary to secure compliance with the provisions of this Act, including –  
**xxxxxx**  
**vi)** by providing it with an annual report in compliance with clause (b) of sub-section (1) of section 4;

It was discussed in detail and agreed that wherever appropriate directions may be issued to the Public Authorities, Under Section 19(8)(a)(vi).
