**Facts:-**

This matter has arisen in pursuance of the earlier orders passed by the Commission on 25.3.2009 in this case.

As per the orders of the Commission an affidavit dated 14.4.2009 has been filed by the I.G. Police, Madhuban-cum-Chairman of the Governing Body of the school. In this affidavit it has been mentioned that the school gets no financial aid/grant from the Government on regular basis. The building of the school was constructed from the funds received from the Central Police Welfare fund and most of the construction related work of the building was carried out by way of voluntary 'Sharamdan' offered by police personnel. However, during the year 2006-07 a sum of Rs. 11,28,400/- was allocated for flooring and Rs. 1,62,000/- for visitors room in the school which was executed by the Haryana Police Housing Corporation. Amounts totaling Rs.60.23 lacs were also received during the period 2004-2008 from the Haryana Police Welfare fund. It has also been clarified that the school did not receive any donation either from the Government or any other private institution except the amounts mentioned above. Attention has also been drawn to the application for affiliation sent to the CBSE during the tenure of the complainant as Principal wherein it was clearly mentioned that it is a non

aided private school. As regards getting the services of police personnel posted in different units of Haryana Armed Police and Haryana Police Academy on temporary basis, a list of 13 employees has been given who were temporarily attached for different durations and drew their salaries from the respective units. As of now only one employee Suman is providing her services in the school.

The appellant contended that information obtained by him from the internet showed that a sum of Rs. 30.00 lacs was sanctioned on 29.5.2008 by the Police Headquarters to the Police Housing Corporation for executing the works connected with the school at Madhuban. He also claimed that the Police Welfare Fund apart from the contribution made by the employees also had a share from the State Government/Police Department. After a careful consideration of the matter, the following directions are, therefore, hereby given in this case: -

1. The I.G. Police, Madhuban-cum-Chairman of the school shall clarify by means of an affidavit the position with regard to the alleged grant of Rs. 30.00 lacs made on 29.5.2008 by the Police Department to the Police Housing Corporation for execution of work connected with the School. It may be clearly stated whether this amount was sanctioned as alleged and if so for what purpose.
2. The I.G. Police, Madhuban-cum-Chairman of the school shall clearly specify whether the Police Welfare Fund has contribution from the department/State Govt. in addition to the contribution made by the employees. If any grants were given to the Police Welfare Fund either by the department or the State Govt., the details of such grants shall be furnished.
3. Compliance of the above two directions shall be made by 30.6.2009 and the original affidavit with a copy to the complainant shall be sent to the Commission by this date. After receipt of this information a hearing shall be scheduled, if considered necessary.
